

SCORE WITH SPURS 2025 ADULT FOOTBALL CAMP 30 MAY, 31 MAY & 1 JUNE 2025

Terms and Conditions

1. The Event

- i. SCORE WITH SPURS 2025 ("Event") is an on-ground football coaching programme organised by AIA Malaysia ("Organiser"), supported by Tottenham Hotspur Football & Athletic Club (THFC) and AIA International Limited (AIA). This Event will be held on Friday, 30 May 2025, Saturday, 31 May 2025 and Sunday, 1 June 2025 at Eco Ardence Setia Alam Football Arena.
- ii. Each coaching session is a half-day session and participant will only attend one (1) of these coaching sessions:
 - a. Session 1: Friday, 30 May, 7:00 pm – 11:00pm
 - b. Session 2: Saturday, 31 May, 4:00pm – 9:00pm
 - c. Session 3: Sunday, 1 June, 4:00pm – 9:00pm
- iii. There are 240 slots available for each session. Registration on www.aia.com.my will open on 23 April 2025.
- iv. The Event will be coached by two (2) Tottenham Hotspur Coaches supported by our local coaches.
- v. There shall be no fees or charges imposed to participate in this Event.
- vi. Please read and understand the Event Terms & Conditions as being a physical activity it will have some reasonable risks.
- vii. By registering and joining the coaching session, participants hereby confirmed that they have read, understood and agree to be bound by these Event Terms and Conditions. Participants also acknowledge the reasonable risks associated with the coaching session and so, do it at their own risk.
 - a) there is a risk of injury associated with participating in the coaching session and certify that participants are in good physical condition with no health-related reasons or problems which preclude their participation in any sports activity;
 - b) in the absence of negligence or other breach of duty by any parties, Participants will not hold or seek to hold the Organiser, THFC, AIA (and any ultimate parent undertaking from time to time and all direct or indirect subsidiaries) or any of their officers, employees, contractors and/or agents responsible for, and hereby release them from any liability in respect of, any personal injury, damage, loss, cost or expense whatsoever suffered by the participant or any other person or in relation to the participant as a result of participating in the coaching session;
 - c) in the absence of any negligence or other breach of duty, Organiser, THFC and/or AIA is not responsible for any theft, damage, destruction or loss of property or belongings while using the facilities; and

- d) nothing in this document affects participant statutory rights in the event that such personal injury, damage, loss, cost or expense is the result of the negligence of the Organiser, THFC and/or AIA.
- viii. In the event that participants need medical attention during the coaching session, participants hereby agree that Organiser may provide and/or arrange for any appropriate and necessary treatment.

2. Eligibility

- i. The Event is open to all Malaysians aged 18 and above, including AIA Malaysia's permanent employees, contract staff and Life Planners ("Participant").
- ii. AIA Malaysia comprises AIA Bhd., AIA PUBLIC Takaful Bhd., AIA General Berhad, AIA Health Services Sdn. Bhd. and AIA Pension and Asset Management Sdn. Bhd.

3. Event Terms Acceptance

- i. Participants who wish to join the Event must register their details via aia.com.my.
- ii. By registering for the Event, the Participant also gives his/her consent for the Organiser to receive and store his/her data as reflected in the registration form.
 - i. This is for the Organiser through its appointed vendors for this Event to verify the Participant's information on the Event Day to allow him/her to enter the Event venue.
 - ii. The Organiser reserves the right to utilise the collected data for marketing purposes
- iii. The Organiser through its appointed vendors for this Event will send an Event email confirmation to those eligible Participants to confirm their spots for the Event via the email addresses given by the Participants during registration, no later than 21 May 2025. This email confirmation will serve as an entry ticket for each Participant for the Event.
- iv. If the selected coaching session is full, the Organiser may assign another coaching session to the Participant, subject to availability.
- v. Participants are required to attend only their assigned session given by the Organiser and are prohibited from exchanging slots. Any attempt to do so will result in denied entry.
- vi. Participants are required to show the email confirmation from the Organiser which will serve as entry tickets to the Event. Entry is strictly not permitted without the Organiser's valid email confirmation.
- vii. Entry ticket to the Event is non-transferable.
- viii. Each Participant shall be entitled to a single-entry registration only. In the event of multiple submissions of registration by any of the Participants, the submissions shall be consolidated as one single-entry registration.
- ix. The Organiser will not be held liable if the Participants cannot be contacted for whatever reasons. In this situation, the Participant's eligibility for the Event will be forfeited and the Organiser reserves the right to select the next qualified Participant. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any losses (including loss of opportunity and any other losses flowing therefrom) and damages suffered in the event the Participant cannot be contacted.

- x. The selection of the participants of the Event shall be deemed final and conclusive under any circumstances and no complaint from any participants will be entertained. The decisions appointed by the Organiser are final, conclusive and binding and no further appeal, enquiry and/or correspondence will be entertained.
- xi. If any sessions are subsequently cancelled (e.g. due to venue problems, bad weather etc.), they will not be rescheduled. If a participant misses a session for any other reason the sessions will not be rescheduled.
- xii. Participants are responsible for arranging and paying for their travel to and from the coaching session venue.
- xiii. Participants acknowledge that no rescheduling will be provided if they withdraw after the coaching session commences and consent to Spurs coaches' discretion in grouping adults by age, size and ability per the FA Code of Good Practice, as far as practicable.
- xiv. Participants must maintain respectful, sportsmanlike, and safe conduct during the coaching session, following all instructions from the Organiser, Spurs coaches and local coaches. Non-compliance may result in immediate removal and potential exclusion from future AIA events.

4. Event Offerings

The Participant is entitled to the following:

- i. One (1) entry to the Event, coaching session guided by Tottenham Hotspur Coaches as well as local coaches;
- ii. One (1) exclusive football training kit ("Kit") that contains the following items:
 - i. Participant t-shirt
 - ii. Shin Guard

Participants are required to wear this t-shirt and shin guard during the coaching session.
- iii. The Organiser reserves the right to modify this and to adjust Participants' chosen t-shirt sizes based on availability.
- iv. Participants are required to bring their own sports shoes or football boots (moulded studs – not spikes or metal studs) to the coaching session.
- v. Participants aged between 18 to 75 years old are eligible for a complimentary Personal Accident insurance coverage during their participation in the Event, subject to the Organiser's sole discretion. The personal accident insurance will not cover participants who submit incomplete and false information and declaration during the registration of this Event. The Organiser reserves the right to reject and deny the Participants' claims.

5. Exclusions /Indemnity

- i. The Organiser, THFC, AIA and its affiliates, authorised dealers/distributors, agents or suppliers shall not be held liable for the following:
 - a. Any delay in performing or partial/total failure to perform any of its obligations to the Participants under this Event if such delay or failure is caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser, its affiliates, authorised dealers/distributors, agents or suppliers, including

- without limitation delays, changes, disruptions, cancellations, diversions or substitutions howsoever caused including without limitation as a result of war, terrorist action or threatened terrorist action, strikes, hostilities, civil commotions, accidents, fire, flood or natural catastrophes; and
- b. From any loss, damage to property, injury, contracted COVID-19, or death resulting from or related to the Participants' participation or inability to participate in this Event, or the use, misuse or inability to use the Kit and/or Prizes from the Event or any portion thereof.
 - ii. The Participants forever waive, release and discharge the Organiser and its affiliates, authorised dealers/distributors, agents or suppliers from and against, any and all liabilities, costs, loss, damages or expenses which the Participant or any party claiming through the Participant hereafter may have arising out of acceptance of any Kit and/or Prizes and/or any food & beverage or participation in the Event including (but not limited to) personal injury and damage to property and whether or not direct, consequential or foreseeable.
 - iii. The Kit, food and beverage as well as prizes from any activities during the Event (Prizes) are given and accepted entirely at the risk of the Participants. Any Kit and/or Prize-related expenses, including tax liabilities (if any) in relation to Event shall be the sole responsibility of the Participants and/or Winners.
 - iv. The Kit and/or Prizes are not exchangeable and/or transferable. Failure to accept a Kit and/or Prize by the Participants prior to the Event or at the Event when required to do so shall constitute a rejection by such Participant(s) and/or Winner(s) and the Organiser reserves its rights to award the Kit and/or Prize to another Participant (s) and/or Winner(s).

6. Unconditional Agreement

- i. Acceptance towards attending the Event constitutes the Participants' unconditional agreement and permission to the Organiser to forever use the Participants' names, video footages, voices, photographs and/or likeness for purposes of advertising, editorial, promotional, marketing, trade and/or other purposes without further compensation and notice, unless prohibited by law. The Organiser reserves the right to such forms of publicity and publication.

7. Laws

- i. This Event shall in all respect be governed by the laws of Malaysia. By entering this Event, the Participants agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of Malaysia.

8. Modifications

- i. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete, vary or amend the terms and conditions herein or change or modify any aspect of this Event, in whole or in part at any time and from time to time and at its sole discretion without notice and without liability to the Participants or any other party. Without prejudice to the aforesaid, the Organiser reserves the right to cancel, terminate or suspend this

Event at any time before with due notice but without any liability or compensation whatsoever. In the event of such cancellation, termination or suspension of this Event, the Organiser may at its sole and absolute discretion choose not to award the Kit and/or Prizes in respect of this Event to the Participants.

9. Cost

- i. All costs incurred by the Participants in relation to and/or with respect to the Event including without limitation postal charges or Internet Service Provider (ISP) charges (if applicable), all transport costs, communication charges, accommodation, meal costs and other related costs incurred by the Participant as a result of and/or pursuant to his/her participation in the Event shall be solely borne by the Participant. The Organiser shall not be under any obligation to reimburse the Participant for any of such costs and expenses incurred thereof.

10. Miscellaneous

- i. The Participants shall not be entitled to assign any of the rights or sub-contract any of the obligations herein. The Organiser shall be entitled to assign or sub-license the whole or any part of its rights hereunder to any third party as may be determined by the Organiser.
- ii. The invalidity, illegality or unenforceability of any terms hereunder shall not affect or impair the continuation in force of the remainder of the Terms and Conditions of the Event.
